

## NAG Library Function Document

### nag\_opt\_nlp\_option\_get\_integer (e04wkc)

#### 1 Purpose

nag\_opt\_nlp\_option\_get\_integer (e04wkc) is used to get the value of an Integer optional argument. nag\_opt\_nlp\_option\_get\_integer (e04wkc) can be used before or after calling nag\_opt\_nlp\_solve (e04wdc).

#### 2 Specification

```
#include <nag.h>
#include <nage04.h>
void nag_opt_nlp_option_get_integer (const char *string, Integer *ivalue,
    Nag_E04State *state, NagError *fail)
```

#### 3 Description

nag\_opt\_nlp\_option\_get\_integer (e04wkc) obtains the current value of an Integer option. For example

```
e04wkc ("Iterations", &itnlim, &state, &fail);
```

will result in the value of the optional argument **Major Iterations Limit** being output in itnlim.

A complete list of optional arguments, their abbreviations, synonyms and default values is given in Section 12 in nag\_opt\_nlp\_solve (e04wdc).

#### 5 Arguments

- 1: **string** – const char \* *Input*  
*On entry:* a single valid keyword of an Integer optional argument (as described in Section 12 in nag\_opt\_nlp\_solve (e04wdc)).
- 2: **ivalue** – Integer \* *Output*  
*On exit:* the Integer value associated with the keyword in **string**.
- 3: **state** – Nag\_E04State \* *Communication Structure*  
**state** contains internal information required for functions in this suite. It must not be modified in any way.
- 4: **fail** – NagError \* *Input/Output*  
 The NAG error argument (see Section 3.6 in the Essential Introduction).

#### 6 Error Indicators and Warnings

##### NE\_BAD\_PARAM

On entry, argument  $\langle value \rangle$  had an illegal value.

**NE\_E04\_OPTION\_INVALID**

The supplied option string is invalid. Check that the keywords are neither ambiguous nor misspelt. The option string is '*value*'.

**NE\_E04WCC\_NOT\_INIT**

Initialization function nag\_opt\_nlp\_init (e04wcc) has not been called.

**NE\_INTERNAL\_ERROR**

An internal error has occurred in this function. Check the function call and any array sizes. If the call is correct then please contact NAG for assistance.
