

# NAG Library Function Document

## nag\_write\_line (x04bac)

### 1 Purpose

nag\_write\_line (x04bac) writes a single line to an external file.

### 2 Specification

```
#include <nag.h>
#include <nagx04.h>
void nag_write_line (Nag_FileID fileid, const char *line)
```

### 3 Description

nag\_write\_line (x04bac) may be used to write to files opened with nag\_open\_file (x04acc).

### 5 Arguments

- 1: **fileid** – Nag\_FileID *Input*  
*On entry:* the identifier of the file to be written to. This must have been returned by a call of nag\_open\_file (x04acc).
- 2: **line** – const char \* *Input*  
*On entry:* a character-string. This is written to the external file as a single record. Trailing blanks are not output, except that if **line** is entirely blank, a single blank character is output.
